INFORMATION FOR PARTICIPANTS

1. GENERAL

1.1. The Inter-Agency Meeting on Outer Space Activities (IAM) will be held on 7-9 March 2012 at the Headquarters of the World Food Programme (WFP).

1.2. The thirty-second session of the IAM will be convened on 7-8 March 2012, followed by the Open informal session for Member States and stakeholders on 9 March 2012.

2. WFP FACILITIES

2.1. The WFP main building is located in Via Cesare Giulio Viola 68/70, Rome, Italy, and is accessible through the Security check point in the picture below (Coordinates: E 12.408032; N 41.822196).



2.2. Security regulations at the WFP require that all participants possess conference badges, which will be issued by Security upon presentation of an appropriate form of identification.

2.3. Participants may wish to communicate their details (name, position, organization, nationality and passport number) by COB 1 March 2012 to the focal points to have their badges issued prior to their arrival to the WFP.

2.4. Once you will get into the WFP premises, you will see a sign where we all will convene and wait before moving to the meeting room which is the Delegates Lounge.

3. TRANSPORTATION

3.1. The braves that wish to test their driving skills in Rome may rent a car at the airport. There are several companies. You may try <http://car-rental.europcar.com/car-rental-ITALY-FIUMICINO.html>

3.2. Rome is a unique city. The taxi system is unique as well. To get a taxi you should call one of the many companies in town. The most popular is available at 06 3570. They do speak English. Tell the operator your address and a cab will arrive in few minutes. The fee is by meter. From the city centre to the WFP offices the driver may charge you 20-30 Euros.

3.3. There is a metropolitan train (Rome-Fiumicino Airport) which stops 5 minutes walking distance from WFP. The station name is Muratella. Trains run every 15 minutes and cost one euro. You may get the train from several stations down town: Ostiense and Trastevere are the best. Ostiense station is reachable from metro line B. Those who are familiar with FAO may use the shuttle between FAO and WFP. It is free once you show the driver your WFP temporary pass.
